Born in ville Loudun, township Chatelleraut, Diocese Poitiers, Poitou (Vienne), France. Baptized at St. Pierre Du Marché, Loudun, France on Sunday 24th Day of Sep, 1662. Godfather Pierre Guiguard and Godmother Francine Bauduais. Pierre emigrated to Canada in 1706 as a militiaman Scottish guard. In 1706 at the Notre Dame Church in Montreal, Pierre married Catharine. Translation of transcript of marriage by Patricia Mc Carron Guindon; "The twenty-first of November one thousand seven hundred and six after one publication of the banns and a dispensation for the other two obtained from Monsignor Francois Vachon of Belmont Grand-Vicaire of Mousignor of Quebec, and there being no objections the Parish of Ville-Marie (Montreal) after having obtained verbal mutual consent from Pierre Guedon aged fourty two years son of Francouis Guedon and Marie Molle his father and mother of the Parish of St. Pierre de Loudun of Poitiers, on the one part, and from Catherine Breza aged twenty seven years Widow of Geoffroy Vincelet dit La Boessiere of this parish on the other part, having married them according to the rites of our Holy Mother in the presence of Dominique Philippe de Rene Gachet surgeon, and Ignace Breza brother of the bride, of Joseph Cartier son of Nicolas Perthuis and many other relatives and friends of both parties. The bride and groom have declared being unable to sign".

Pierre Guedon/Guindon from Archives in Loudun France (via Ghislaine Guindon of St. Gabriel de Brandon, Quebec):

"Pierre and his brother, Jean Guindon came from Saint-Pierre-du-Martray Parish, Loudun, France to "New France" as a volunteer. On August 6, 1688 Francois Hazeur, who had a tradesman service in Quebec, hired Pierre to work ar the water mill under construction in Malbale.

Jean was hospitalized in 1689, 1693, and 1696 at Hotel-Dieu (hospital) Quebec. Jean Guindon decided to go back to France in 1696.

Pierre fled France due to religious wars and to the pestilence (epidemic disease/plague) according to the archivist of Loudun, France.

According to Pierre's pre-arranged agreement, Pierre married Catherine Barza or Breza (born 1696?), on November 21, 1706 in Montreal. (Catherine's father's name was Andre Barza dit Lafleur and her mother: Francois Pilois.) Three children were born from their union between 1707 and 1710, in St-Francois-de-Sales, Jesus Isle. Catherine Barsa died while giving birth to her third son, Paul, on August 21, 1710.

On February 15, 1711, Pierre signed a marriage agreement with Anne Charbonneau (Guillaume Labelle's widow), witnessed by Senet, the notary public. It seems that this marriage agreement was cancelled, because the religious wedding did not take place.

Pierre died September 26, 1733; buried September 27, 1733, in St-Francois-de-Sales cemetery.

1636 Jan 15 Isle Jesus and other small adjacent islands, were granted to the Jesuits as fief and seigneury from the New France Company. This island was called "de Montmagny", after the New France governor and one of the New France Company directors.

1706 St. Francois parish built close to the SeigneurialManor and Saint Mathieu Chapel, and Enfant-Jesus Chapel

1716 The first banal mill (the people paid a fee to the lord to use the mill) was situated on the Rivieredes-Pairies, to the west of the principal manor, between a small rocky island and Isle Jesus. 1735 St. Francois Mill was joined to the north bank of the river of the island via "Montee du Moulin"

1721 Fire destroyed Banal Mill, Seigneurial Manor, and the Enfant-Jesus Chapel.

In Loudun, France, there were three main brances of Guedons. One branch specialized in making hat/bonnets, the second were shoemakers and the third branch were butchers. Our ancestors were butchers as was Pierre Guedon (Guindon) who came over to Canada at the age of 21 years with his older brother Jean. There is no further trace of Jean and it is supposed he died on the trip or returned to France. Pierre is the only one from the Loudun region who stayed in Canada. Many others settled mainly in Acadia (the Maritimes) but returned to France before the mass deportation."
